Full Governing Body

Pay and Personnel Committee

Remit: Staffing/personnel, including pay.

Resources (including buildings) Committee

Remit includes finance; health and safety; buildings and grounds maintenance.

Standards and Curriculum Committee

Remit includes curriculum offering (and values, needs of pupils, opportunities, equality); progress and attainment (including quality of teaching and learning); disadvantaged and vulnerable children (their needs and progress; ensuring relevant statutory requirements are met).

GLOSSARY

EAL	English as an Additional Language
EYFS	Early Years Foundation Stage - The early years foundation stage sets standards for the learning, development and care of children from birth to 5 years old. All schools and Ofsted-registered early years providers must follow the EYFS, including childminders, preschools, nurseries and school reception classes.
LAC	Looked after child(ren). A child who has been in the care of their local authority for more than 24 hours is known as a looked after child. LAC are also often referred to as children in care.
OPAL	Outdoor Play and Learning. Programme for primary schools to improve the quality of day-to-day play times.
PP	Pupil Premium – grant funding to improve educational outcomes for disadvantaged pupils in state-funded schools in England. The grant also provides support for children and young people with parents in the regular armed forces, referred to as service pupil premium (SPP).
SEND	Special educational needs and disabilities.
