Year 3 Home Learning Summer 1

Our Year 3 weekly home learning expectations are:-

Reading: read your school reading book five times per week. Record reading in your reading diary. Reading diaries along with your reading book need to be in school every day.

Times tables: develop your times tables fluency using Times Table Rockstars. By the end of Year 3 children are expected to be fluent in their **3s**, **4s**, **6s** and **8s** times tables, having learnt their 2s, 5s and 10s in KS1. You can find out what your child knows by looking at their heatmap on Times Tables Rockstars.

Spellings: Learn your weekly spellings for testing every Friday. Use your EdShed login to practice spellings online in Spelling Shed.

If you do not have Times Tables Rockstars or EdShed log-ins, check on Arbor or speak to your class teacher.

Each term, you are also expected to complete at least one of these projects which you will bring in to share with the class. The deadline is Tuesday 20th May – this is so that we can share our work in class during the last week.

<u>History</u> Choose an area about Ancient Egypt that you are interested in, for example, the Egyptian Gods. Create a fact file about your area of interest. You could do this on paper or by using a computer.	<u>Maths</u> Use your knowledge of nets to build an Egyptian themed monument, for example, one of the pyramids at Giza or the Sphinx.
PSHE Create a poster to warn other children about hazards they might find around their homes, such as electrical hazzards, fires or sharp objects.	<u>Science/ Computing</u> Grow your own plant and create a diary about it growing from a seed into a plan. You may choose to do this on a computer or to write it by hand. You could grow cress or a sunflower or something else you think would grow in time.
