## <u>English</u>

Free write! Write a story about any topic you would like. Make sure to have a clear: beginning, dilemma, resolution, ending.

Make sure you include the Year 5 techniques such as: relative clauses, sentence structures, expanded noun phrases and upscaled vocabulary.

### <u>Maths</u>

Create a game to help a peer with division. This could include quick fire questions, worded problems and formal methods. Remember you are trying to help somebody learn this so you need to include examples. Could you include resources for them to use?

#### <u>History</u>

Carry out some research and create either a poster or PowerPoint about World War 2.

## <u>PE</u>

Design your own obstacle course to improve someone's agility (ability to move and change direction quickly). You need to think of what pieces of equipment would be needed, which age range it is suitable for and how you would see if their agility has improved. We could try some of these as warm ups in our PE lessons!
